Registration Fee Taxes

The Washington State Department of Revenue has ruled that sales tax must be collected on any league fees. The Aberdeen Parks and Recreation Department has not collected this in the past.

This will also affect registrations for other programs and activities across the state. This may include our children's out of town bus trips, facility rentals, and other activities with participation fees administered by the Ab-

erdeen Parks and Recreation Department.
