

Per House Bill 1934 - "Renewing a concealed pistol license by members of the armed forces"

The Aberdeen Police Department will renew CPLs through a mail application process for Aberdeen residents who as a member of the armed forces, which includes the National Guard, and Armed Forces Reserves, are unable to renew their CPL in person because of assignment, reassignment, or deployment for out of state military service.

A person applying for a renewal CPL under these circumstances shall;

- Provide a copy of their orders designating the specific period of assignment, reassignment, or deployment for out of state service.
- Apply for renewal within 90 days before or after the expiration date of the CPL.
- Pay the renewal licensing fee or late renewal fee – depending on the date of application.
- Pass a background check.

A CPL renewed under these circumstances take effect on the expiration date of the prior license and is valid for a period of one year.
