

RULES OF CONDUCT - CITY OF ABERDEEN
TEMPORARY ALTERNATIVE SHELTER LOCATION (“TASL”)
*** FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE RULES MAY RESULT IN REMOVAL FROM TASL ***

GENERAL RULES

1. All persons sheltering at this location must show proof of participation in “Coordinated Entry” event within one week of accessing this location; not more than 2 persons are allowed per site.
2. No person under the age of 18 (eighteen) years allowed on location.
3. All guests must sign in, and agree to follow rules of conduct.
4. After one night’s absence from TASL, staff will post a notice on the site shelter reminding occupant that an absence of 3 consecutive overnights will result in losing shelter. After 3 consecutive overnights’ absence, personal property will be collected and stored according to the City’s procedures for 60 days. If personal property is not retrieved within 60 days it is subject to donation or disposal by the City.
 - a. Reasonable accommodation will be made on a case-by-case basis for extenuating circumstances.
5. All areas must be clear of litter and debris
6. Treat all persons at the property civilly and with respect;
 - a. Only take or use the property of another if you have express permission
 - b. Do not obstruct City or other personnel in the performance of their duties.
 - c. No brandishing or threatening with weapons; no yelling, shouting, fighting or otherwise aggressive behavior

PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE RULES

1. Abide by all applicable federal, state, and local laws.
2. No fires or open flames; smoking only in designated location
3. Personal property at each site is to be within each shelter; to the extent personal property is outside the shelter, it must fit into the container provided (currently a 27-gallon tote, measuring approximately 30 inches * 20 inches * 14 inches).
4. To avoid pest infestation, no perishable food items or cooking on site
 - a. Local programs providing meals are listed at the entry area, as well as during the Coordinated Entry event held every week.
 - b. “Perishable food item” is an item that is likely to spoil, decay or become unsafe to consume without refrigeration
 - i. “Fast” or prepared food may be consumed onsite
 - ii. Non-perishable food items should be stored in a sealed container
5. Portable toilets and trash containers are provided; if they appear to be full or need servicing contact the designated site staff person.
 - a. Portable toilets are for human waste only
 - b. Trash containers are for trash only
 - c. Debris or medical waste must be properly disposed of
 - d. Vandalizing or destroying toilets or trash containers is against the law, and the City will pursue legal remedy if toilets or other property is damaged
6. The following items are prohibited:
 - a. Alcohol, Marijuana, Controlled Substances without a prescription
 - b. No Illegal weapons
 - c. Toxic Liquids or Materials
 - d. Flammable, Explosive, Corrosive, Combustible, Corrosive Materials
 - e. Stolen Property
 - f. Putrid/Rotting Materials

HOURS OF ENTRY AND QUIET HOURS

1. Hours of Entry are between 6:00 am and 10:00 pm, unless prior arrangements have been made
2. Persons seeking shelter between the hours of 10:00 pm and 6:00 am may be admitted if there is an available site, and they agree to follow the rules of conduct.
3. Quiet hours are observed between 10:00 pm and 6:00 am, during which time sounds should not travel beyond the boundaries of your site.

PET RULES

1. Up to two pets per site are permitted
2. Pet owners must clean up after their pet(s)
3. Pets must be on leash, at heel, or otherwise contained at all times in this location
4. Pets cannot be dangerous, diseased, or aggressive and remain at this location

TRANSPORTATION/VEHICLES:

1. Each person may keep one operational bicycle at this location; a bike rack will be provided for parking that bike.
2. No motorized vehicles allowed onsite; the City does not provide parking for vehicles
